Bing cherries and strawberry candy on the nose leads to a smooth caress of warm, ripe strawberries, dried mixed berries, sultry, soft fruit lingers on the palate.
- 2017 Argyle, Brut, Willamette Valley, Oregon 64
Tension and mineral backbone, fresh seashore, white peach, a creamy center and long, graceful finish
- 2016 Elk Cove, La Bohème Brut Rosé, Willamette Valley, Oregon 95
Sweet summer strawberries, candied orange blossoms, saturated with tangerine, and grapefruit flavors
- 2014 Adelsheim, Brut Rosé, Ribbon Springs Vineyard, Willamette Valley, Oregon 112
Quiet elegance, ripe strawberry, full of life and vibrancy, distinctly dynamic in its approach, yet lithe and structured, providing a grounding note
- NV Louis Roederer, Collection 242, Champagne, France 120
The blend is dominated by Chardonnay which was of exceptional quality in the 2017 vintage. Its aromas of ripe, sweet fruit complemented by subtle oaky notes. The palate is rich and ripe, with a luxurious texture that coats the palate
- 2015 Adelsheim, Sparkling Wine, Blanc de Blancs, Willamette Valley, Oregon 134
Quiet elegance, ripe strawberry, full of life and vibrancy, distinctly dynamic in its approach, yet lithe and structured, providing a grounding note
- NV Moët & Chandon Imperial, Brut, Champagne, France 135
The delicious sumptuousness of white-fleshed fruits: pear, peach, & apple coalesce in the alluring caress of fine bubbles. The finish is a soft vivacity of citrus fruit and nuances of gooseberry
- 2008 Nicolas Feuillatte, Palmes d'Or, Brut, Champagne, France 173
Aromas of fresh white fruits, apricot, dried almond, with a hint of spice will reach a dramatic crescendo on the palate. Distinguished and refined, textured with the gentle touch of gossamer bubbles
- 2014 Louis Roederer, Cristal, Brut, Champagne, France 300
The fragrance is fresh, alluring, with slightly smoky, hazelnutty notes and a suggestion of orange peel. There's a salty lining to a core of deliciously ripe, citrus zesty fruit acidity that adds length to a finely balanced, youthful, hedonistic Champagne of serious depth and vinosity

CHARDONNAY

- 2020 St. Francis, Sonoma County, California 50
This elegant and expressive Chardonnay bursts with flavors of apples, pears, and citrus, followed by crisp acidity and a rich, lingering finish
- 2021 Pete's Mountain, Carson's Reserve, Willamette Valley, Oregon 63
Alluring notes of tropical fruits and subtle oak spices. Flavors of clementine and yellow peach. Silky texture, lifted by the minerality. Barrel aged in 50% new oak for ten months
- 2018 Adelsheim, Staking Claim, Willamette Valley, Oregon 69
Vivid aromas of lemon curd, Asian pear, white flowers, Bergamot, orange zest, and cardamom. The flavors of lemon curd and Asian pear carry into the mouth accompanied by a wet stone minerality
- 2017 Sokol Blosser, Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon 70
Honeysuckle, pineapple and pear nose with luscious tropical fruit, bright acidity and long finish
- 2020 Cakebread Cellars, Napa Valley, California 92
Crisp and vibrant with citrus, nectarine and melon
- 2014 Authentique, Keeler Estate Vineyard, Eola-Amity Hills, Oregon 95
White flower, Anjou pear, golden delicious apple, lovely barrel spice, broad, lush with tight grain oak
- 2019 Kistler Vineyards, Les Noisetiers Sonoma Coast, California 127
This is a classic balance of layered, juicy fruit and mineral backbone. White flowers and stone fruit aromatics leading to a full bodied, juicy core, loaded with flavors of peach, apricots, pineapple and pear
- 2019 Beaux Frères, Gran Moraine, Yamhill-Carlton, Oregon 132
Aromas of lemon, peach and honeycomb, orange blossom and candlewax; all evolving into an expansive palate of richness and medium weight, while maintaining focus and balance
- 2016 Bergstrom, Sigrid, Willamette Valley, Oregon 134
Explosively aromatic, rich and balanced, showcasing hazelnut, saffron, lime blossom & lemon on the nose

Hints of pear tart and green apple, jasmine and honeysuckle with luscious white peaches

Dynamic aromatics and lingering crispness, stone and citrus fruits with tropical notes
- 2020 Gruner Veltliner, Sineann Winery, Willamette Valley, Oregon 48
Spicy stone fruits, white pepper and citrus with mineral qualities
- 2017 Dry Gewurztraminer, Dowsett Family, Columbia Gorge, Walla Walla, Washington 49
Appealing aromas of rose petal, ginger, pink grapefruit and lychee lead to dry, broad-feeling fruit flavors
- 2019 Riesling, Poet's Leap, Columbia Valley, Washington 50
Key Lime and fresh citrus peel aromas give way to vivid layers of white peach and stone fruit flavors accented by a pleasant touch of minerality. Delicious natural acidity and a lengthy finish

An assertive, dry wine characterized by beautiful floral aromas and fruity flavors that finishes with refreshing acidity

This bright, refreshing Sauvignon Blanc has lovely aromas of grapefruit and citrus
- 2021 Rosé, "Sisters" Pete's Mountain Vineyard, Willamette Valley, Oregon 53
Alluring aromas of peach and warm strawberries. Sweet notes of red pear and clementine oranges with the perfect amount of acidity on the finish
- 2017 Pinot Blanc, WillaKenzie, Willamette Valley, Oregon 60
Nose of honeydew, Bosc pear, citrus with flavors of lemon, apricot, almonds, white flowers and apples
- 2013 Riesling, Trisaetum, Off-Dry, Coastal Range, Willamette Valley, Oregon 60
Minerality and firm acid backbone, Kabinett-style, barely off-dry, crisp finish
- 2017 Pinot Gris, Alexana Estate, Willamette Valley, Oregon 67
On the nose, notes of fig and red apple. On the palate, rich & rounded flavors present themselves with melon & citrus notes
- 2018 Viognier, Penner-Ash, Newberg, Oregon 75
Aromas of peach, stone fruit, and white flowers with tropical notes. Dense and creamy texture with green pear-skin, honeydew melon, tart peach and exotic spice on the palate
- 2020 Rosé, Adelsheim, Heritage 91, Willamette Valley, Oregon 99
Lovely aromas of fresh strawberry, white peach, and lemon verbena lift out of the glass. The palate is smooth and supple, the plushness supported by a refreshing core of acid-driven firmness

PINOT NOIR

- 2018 Montinore Estate, Willamette Valley, Oregon 47
Medium in body with notes of ripe Bing cherries, plum and chocolate that blend with an array of wild berries
- 2020 Pete's Mountain, Haley's Block, Willamette Valley, Oregon 53
Impeccably balanced with aromas of dark cherry and orange zest. Notes of red plums and black currants. The finish is sweet with layers of vanilla, tobacco and cherry
- 2019 Stoller, Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon 59
The nose is bright, showing perfumed red fruits with undertones of earth and baking spice. The palate soft and supple, with dark cherry flavors balanced by a delicate tension from the tannins
- 2018 North Valley, Willamette Valley, Oregon 64
Ripe raspberry, blueberry & black fruits, soft tannins silky on the palate with licorice and vanilla bean flavors. Smooth and balanced
- 2019 Adelsheim, Breaking Ground, Willamette Valley, Oregon 69
Aromas of roasted spices, black raspberries, lilacs, dark loam and bramble. Flavor follows with notes of cocoa nibs, toasted anise seed, and black cherry
- 2015 Siltstone, Guadalupe Slope, Willamette Valley, Oregon 74
Medium-bodied, complex with red fruit, black tea and truffle undertones. Silky tannins, fresh acidity
- 2014 Sineann, Schwab Vineyard, Willamette Valley, Oregon 80
Silky dark fruit, cassis, smooth and balanced, flavorful and lingers beautifully on the palate
- 2019 Elk Cove, Five Mountain, Willamette Valley, Oregon 87
Lush aromas of huckleberry, licorice and violet introduce this pretty wine. Generous strawberry on the palate is complemented by grainy tannins with flavors of bay leaf, cocoa and black tea
- 2019 Elk Cove, La Bohème, Willamette Valley, Oregon 90
Black cherry, forest floor and hints of rose petal and orange peel introduce a wine of great clarity. Juicy blackberry and fresh red cherry lead into a long silky finish of savory bay leaf and sea spray
- 2017 Pete's Mountain, Kristina's Reserve, Willamette Valley, Oregon 92
Bright and balanced acidity, soft tannins with cherry and blueberry
- 2018 Adelsheim, McCollum Heritage 91, Willamette Valley, Oregon 99
Opening with layers of cedar spice, fresh cherries, dusty violets, and freshly turned soil this wine delivers all that and more on the palate. Smooth, supple tannins provide support and intrigue, and the finish just goes on and on.
- 2017 Bergström, Gregory Ranch, Willamette Valley, Oregon 124
Very complex, dark aromas of chocolate, coffee, ripe juicy blackberries, plums and red roses. The mouth is rich and savory with strong floral expression and also cassis
- 2018 Sokol Blosser, Estate Cuvée, Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon 114
The nose is rich with mushroom, truffle, and forest floor, accompanied by black cherry, cranberry, and clove. The palate reflects the cranberry, black cherry and truffle, but also introduces a dash of black pepper with medium tannins and acidity on the finish
- 2017 Elk Cove, Roosevelt, Willamette Valley, Oregon 140
Hints of balsamic and vanilla on the nose. Big and rich with lush ripe red fruit to balance out the considerable oak component
- 2017 Adelsheim, Boulder Bluff Vineyard, Willamette Valley, Oregon 136
Top notes of blueberry and cassis and the spice aromas folded into this wine. There's also an enticing thread of cedar wood ash. The wine has lovely chewy tannins and a rounded, velvety texture that persists into the long finish
- 2017 Domaine Serene, "Evenstad Reserve", Willamette Valley, Oregon 141
Smooth with dark berry, cherry, licorice and spice

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 2018 Pete's Mountain, Elijah's Reserve, Horse Heaven Hills, Washington 63
Explosive aromas of blackberry, rich current and cherry, barrel aged notes of cedar, mocha and a hint of vanilla. Chocolate, raspberry and ripe strawberry on the finish
- 2019 Cor Cellars, McKinley Springs Vineyard, Horse Heaven Hills, Washington 77
Luxurious, ripe and aromatic. Bold flavors of black cherry, all spice and chocolate throughout the finish
- 2018 Tamarack, Walla Walla Valley, Washington 81
Notes of deep red fruit, including raspberry, boysenberry and currant on the nose, followed by leather, black pepper and cassis. The palate brings mouth-watering tannins with lingering red fruit, especially red cherry, flavors of rich meats on the mid palate, with a balanced, smooth finish
- 2018 Griffin Creek, Rogue Valley, Southern Oregon 83
Aromas of boysenberry, currant, cassis and vanilla emerge on the highly perfumed nose and elegantly lead to a palate filled with dark fruit flavors and baking spices
- 2017 Ferraro Cellar, Phinny Hill, Columbia Valley, Washington 83
Theme of black cherry and cedar shavings; ripe plum with rich chocolate like tannins
- 2018 Abeja, Columbia Valley, Washington 117
Full-bodied, luscious black fruit with silky tannins, bright acidity and exceptional finish
- 2019 Quilceda Creek, Columbia Valley, Washington 239
Blackberry, blueberry, and plum fruit, violet, Asian soy, smoke and black tea

SYRAH

- 2019 Owen Roe, Ex Umbris, Columbia Valley, Washington 64
Warm pie berries and caramel scents with a smooth body leading to juicy dark red fruit and tobacco
- 2018 L'Ecole, No.41 Columbia Valley, Washington 82
Sweet & savory complexity, with dark aromas of blackberry, black cherry, violet, licorice, and crushed rock. Fruit forward and velvety on the palate, this varietally expressive Syrah presents silky tannins, plush mocha, and spiced cinnamon carried by notable freshness
- 2017 Griffin Creek, Rogue Valley, Oregon 84
Chocolate covered cherries, raspberry, dark notes of blueberry, velvety tannins
- 2016 Owen Roe, Chapel Block, Red Willow Vineyard, Yakima Valley, Washington 97
Brilliant notes of blueberry and brambleberry aromas. Flavors of blackberry fruit leather and violet are nicely layered within a velvety texture interlaced with hints of star anise and black pepper
- 2010 Hawks View Cellars, California Syrah, Willamette Valley, Oregon 105
Lush and velvety with blackberry, blueberry and cinnamon
- 2016 Lillian Winery, California Syrah, Dundee, Oregon 142
Deeply colored, great nose. Full bodied, carrying flavors of rich and intense dark blue and black fruit, dark cocoa. Long, luxurious finish
- 2013 Lillian Winery, California Syrah, Gold Series #03, Dundee, Oregon 160
Inky ruby. Powerful, smoke-accented black and blue fruit liqueur, incense, exotic spice and potpourri scents carry a potent mineral overtone. Deeply concentrated, expansive and alluringly sweet, offering palate-staining blackberry, boysenberry, cola and violet pastille flavors with hints of star anise, allspice and bitter chocolate. Distinctly rich but energetic as well. The impressively long finish features sneaky, building tannins and insistent florality

MERLOT

- 2018 Zerba, Columbia Valley, Washington 87
Lots of red fruit on nose, strawberries and dark cherry, with some lavender on the back end. Fruit dies on palate and rolls into a peppery, acidic finish. Minimum tannins. Short finish
- 2011 K Vintners, Stoneridge Vineyard, Washington 86
Supple and expressive, layering cherry and spice flavors with blankets of mint and green herbs, coming together smoothly on the generous finish. The tannic backbone is well-integrated
- 2017 Pedestal, Columbia Valley, Washington 125
Offering blackberry jus, spiced plum preserves and dark cherry skin, the scents are lifted and compounded by rich, elegant oak spices, cigar box and juicy tobacco

OTHER RED VARIETALS

- 2018 Red Blend, Cana's Feast Bricco Red, Columbia Valley, Washington 50
Leads with bold red fruit, followed by earthy undertones of tobacco, and leather. The finish hints at a touch of baking spices
- 2017 Zinfandel, Seghesio, Sonoma, California 60
Blue, red, and black fruits, medium to full body, a supple texture, and vibrant acidity
- 2015 Red Blend, Mista Rosso, Ferraro Cellar, Columbia Valley, Washington 64
Aromas and flavors of dark fruits, black cherry, blackberries, plums with a hint of spice and a lingering finish
- 2015 Malbec, Reustle, Golgatha Bloc, Umpqua Valley, Oregon 69
Aromas of marionberry, plumb and blueberry, followed by smoked paprika and Argentine leather. Flavors of blackberry and blueberry, dried plumb with earthy and cedar notes at the finish
- 2020 Rhone-style Blend, Syncline, Subduction Red, Columbia Valley, Washington 70
This wine brings levity to your palate with flavors of plum, black cherry, and savory notes, followed by aromas of early summer berries, Garrigue, and the dry sagebrush lands of the eastern Washington desert
- 2018 Cabernet Franc, Zerba, Walla Walla Valley, Washington 77
The wine opens with aromas of cassis, black cherry, spiced chocolate, anise, cigar box and graphite followed by flavors of red plum fruit with notes of sassafras, baking spice and roasted cocoa nibs. All nicely framed with fine-grained tannins and fresh acidity
- 2018 Red Blend, Saggi, Columbia Valley, Washington 116
Elaborately fragrant, brimming with red cherries, ripe strawberries and notes of nutmeg. Vibrant and well-integrated with balanced natural acidity, this is a textured wine with great richness and flavors that linger across a generous finish
- 2019 Red Blend, Ridge Vineyards, Three Valleys, Sonoma, California 98
Deep garnet-red color. Aromas of ripe raspberry and cherry fruits, fresh mint, exotic spices, with clay-earth minerals. Beautiful briary fruits on entry, medium-full body, integrated tannins, and great persistence to the finish
- 2014 Red Blend, Alexana Estate, Gran Coeur, Columbia Valley, Washington 99
Polished round tannins are enhanced by notes of mocha, blackberry and fig
- 2018 Sangiovese, Leonetti Cellars, Walla Walla Valley, Washington 159
A nose of dark Bing cherries, strawberries, dried rose petals, fresh cream, and a hint of asphalt. Incredibly polished tannins on top of a core of silky fruit and earth notes. A lengthy finish with a lovely, refreshing string of acidities
